In April 2003 the National Security Agency (NSA) and the Committee on National Security Systems (CNSS) awarded Cisco formal certification recognizing that Cisco security courseware meets the 4011 training standard. - CSIDS-Cisco Secure Intrusion Detection System (or IDSPM)




